
## POWERFUL QUESTION DRILL DOWN AND PERFORMANCE STUDY TOOLS





b) Alternatively, you can click the All Questions Drill Down button in white. This will show a color coded table of all the math questions answered across exams and exercises shown below.




If you click on any row, the details of that question will pop up, including question, answers, and answer explanations, often presented in video form. Furthermore, you can filter this table to review only wrong answers across all exams, or hard questions only, or to filter by a single topic like ratios shown below.
